If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must ensure that a parent guardian signs their entry form giving consent to a drug test if requested. Under the provisions within the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, GNAS, the Tournament Organiser & working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. Any archer with a chronic medical condition is asked to notify the Tournament Organiser (in complete confidence) so that appropriate action can be taken in the event of a recurrence.

The highest scoring Teams will receive individual MEDALS. Team members must be shooting rounds for which they are eligible for national records.

The highest scoring husband and wife archers will be awarded the Jack & Jill Trophy.

A Recurve team will consist of three archers from one club, including at least one lady or junior.

A Compound Team will consist of three archers from one club, including at least one lady or junior.

A Longbow Team will consist of three archers from one club.

Shooting will be under GNAS rule 304 paragraph f), Method 2
i.e. 6 arrows ends, **not** 3+3
